Hillary Clinton became the first woman to be nominated as a presidential candidate of the United States.

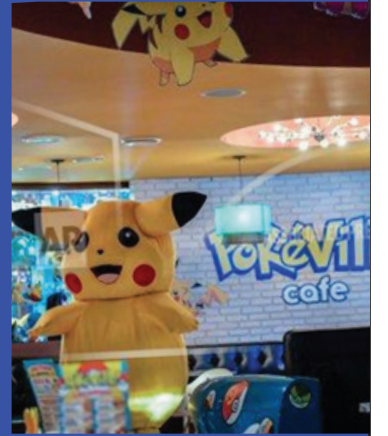

## Lollapalooza celebrated its 25th anniversary

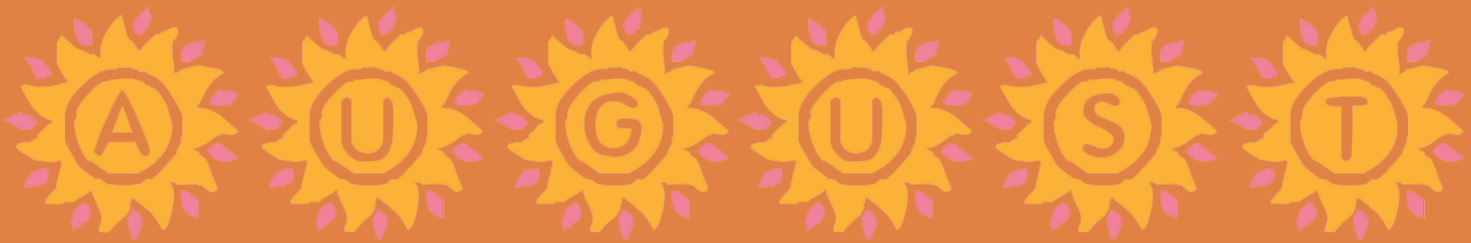

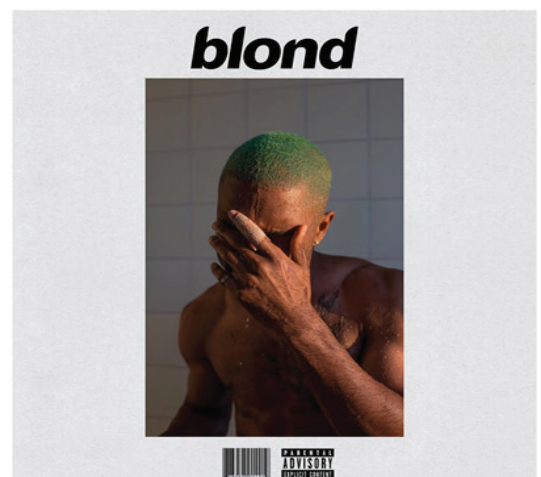
